Malcolm selected his DJI Mini 2 for the job. This is an amazing bit of kit and is very small so doesn't cause undue alarm amongst the public.

Malcolm used 2 of the semi automatic video programs – one which pulls up and away from the start point called a "Dronie" (Drone Selfie) and another which circles a preselected object. The pilot has to select the start point and height taking into account obstacles etc. At Impington it was pretty easy, but at Histon there were several very tall trees so a bit of preparation was needed including dummy runs that we had to abort as the drone was about to fly into the trees.



The Mavic Mini 2 casts its shadow in the graveyard – possibly the first time a drone has been flown here!!

What is really incredible is that the drone is so small and relatively cheap at under £500 yet is packed with features and takes a stabilised HD video that looks fantastic.

You might like to think of this type of drone as an automatic and very tall tripod that is packed with clever features rather than a racing quad style of drone which is a different beast entirely.




