

## **IVCMAC – Minutes of the AGM held 7<sup>th</sup> December 2022**

The meeting was held by Zoom and the purpose was to approve the annual report that had been sent to all members on 26<sup>th</sup> November, and then to discuss any other business that members wanted to raise.

### **Chairmans remarks**

Chairman John Wynn remarked that it had been a good year for the club and full advantage was taken of the ending of Covid restrictions. A full programme of events took place as described in the report. Thanks must go to all members of the club who contribute to the various events and activities.

John also highlighted the point that the new Saturday indoor flying sessions are an attempt to get the best flying options for members, but after they have been tried for a while, the committee will be very open to suggestions for further improvements.

The following items were raised as AOB and then included in the final version of the annual report as items 3 onwards (items 1 and 2 having been raised and answered prior to the AGM).

**AOB item 3** – Paul Hoey asked that the assistance to the club provided by the BMFA East Anglia area be noted. The club are very grateful for this assistance which included very nice prizes for the first public open day in April, a donation of £200 to purchase BMFA freebies for the Cubs visit in July and setting up the marvellous Duxford flying day in October – hopefully to be repeated in 2023.

**AOB item 4** – John Wynn asked that Michael Marshalls work in organising the Sculthorpe free flight gala over many years be recognised. This is a great event and much looked forward to and the committee thank Michael for his hard work.

**AOB item 5** – Stuart raised the issue of flight safety. George Adam also commented that we must all be aware of the risks whether indoors or outdoors and not be afraid to step in and advise if any unsafe conditions develop. This applies not only to club members, but also to the general public who may appear on site. The guidelines for Friday evening flying on the field have been amended to say there is to be no RC or CL flying till any footballers have been asked to move to the far end of the field and out of harms way.

**AOB item 6** – John Clarke said that he would implement Gordon Hannahs proposal for a members contact list in February once the membership renewals were completed. We would attempt to list members interests as well.

**AOB item 7** – The committee voted to give their thanks to Ann for her work as treasurer over many years and to make her an honorary member of the club.
