Cottenham Flying site guidelines

By agreement with Cottenham Parish council, IVCMAC club members as honorary "friends of Cottenham residents", can fly model aircraft at the Cottenham Recreation ground.

- The recreation ground is signposted off Lambs Lane, Cottenham
- Park in the car park (Blue Arrow) and walk 200 yds through an obvious gap in the hedge to the 3rd field shown marked in red. NB the entrance lane is closed off 2.30 to 3.30 during school drop off times
- We usually set up the pits just to the right of the gap in the hedge and then stand 20 yards in front of the pits to fly
- Only electric aircraft are allowed
- No flying over the sports fields behind the hedge marked as a blue line in the picture helow
- The site is kept well mown so is very suitable for take offs by wheeled aircraft
- The best times to fly are Mondays to Fridays up to about 6pm when the field is usually completely clear
 - o Weekends can see football matches in the winter, but usually finished by 4pm.
 - o On some summer weekday evenings after 6pm there can be sports training
 - Even if there is activity, we can usually fly at the far end of the field if we are careful – experienced flyers only if there are other people about!
 - o Watch out for the occasional walker or jogger
