Waterbeach flying site details

This site is not an official club site but we have had permission to use it for quiet electric models. It is on the old Waterbeach Barracks site. Entry is via the old barracks entrance that is now open to the public and then follow the road round to the right.

Important – They have asked us not to post any video on social media, so please take care not to do this or we may lose use of the site.

They have also asked us not to move any bollards on the access road and to park with the other cars in the main car park **marked in blue**.

The site is patrolled by ex Ghurka security guards, so if challenged tell them that we have had permission from Caroline Ward at the development company Urban and Civic. The site will eventually be developed for a new school. The accommodation blocks are being used as nurses accommodation.

The flying site **marked in red** is suitable mainly for hand launched models, but there is a hard cricket pitch in the middle that can be used for take offs.
