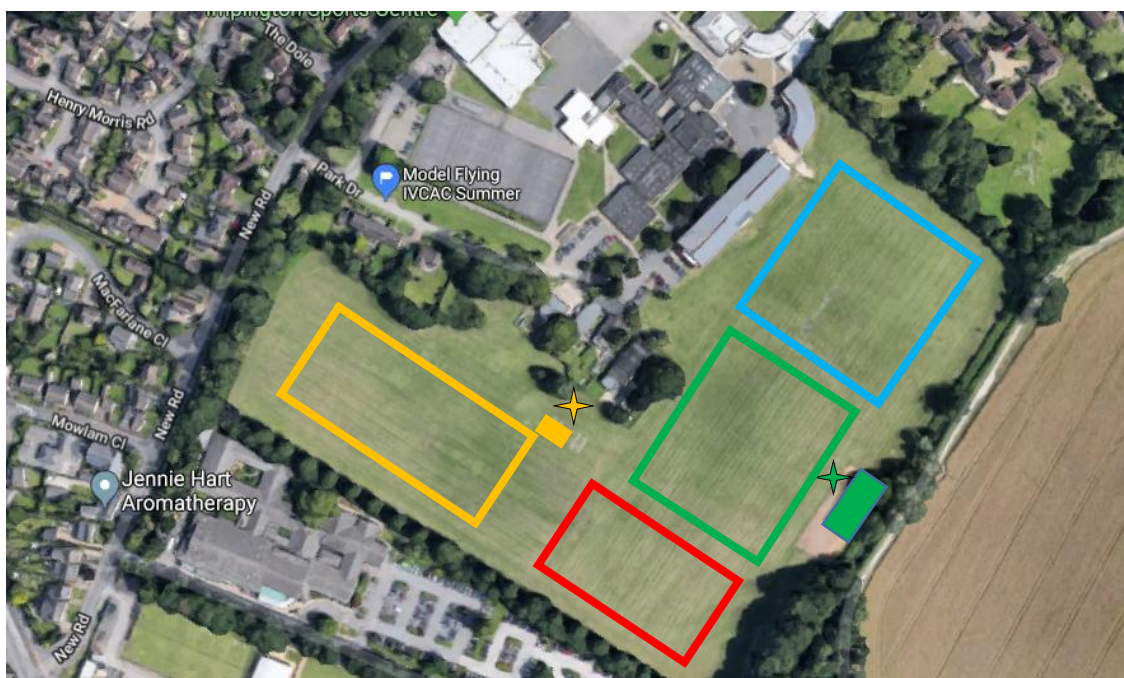
The field layout and flying areas are shown below

Blue – Free Flight

Red – Control Line

Green – RC fixed wing Pits, Pilots (✦) and landing / take off area

Yellow – Low level Quad course, take off area and pilots (✦)



For Impington club members flying RC and drones, the normal Friday evening guidelines apply, but as usual we will operate fixed wing RC from the sandpit area to keep the sun behind us.

You can drive your car onto the field and park along the South East hedge, but avoid driving on marked pitches.

11.30 – 12.00 – Most RC parachutes dropped and in the air at the same time

13.00 – 13.15 – Most models in the air record attempt. Includes FF, RC, CL and drones

13.00 – 13.15 – Included in the above attempt a "most Malmstrom FF models in the air".

13.30 – 14.00 – Longest RC streamer competition

15.00 – 15.30 – RC combat with 10m streamers (get a tatty model ready!!)
